1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to immunization against human papillomavirus.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 38.001, Education Code, is amended by
1-13 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as
1-14 follows:

1-15 (b) Subject to Subsections (b-1) and [Subsection] (c), the
1-16 executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission
1-17 [Texas Board of Health] may modify or delete any of the
1-18 immunizations in Subsection (a) or may require immunizations
1-19 against additional diseases as a requirement for admission to any
1-20 elementary or secondary school.

1-21 (b-1) Immunization against human papillomavirus is not
1-22 required for a person's admission to any elementary or secondary
1-23 school; however, by using existing resources, the Health and Human
1-24 Services Commission shall provide educational material about the
1-25 human papillomavirus vaccine that is unbiased, medically and
1-26 scientifically accurate, and peer reviewed, available to parents or
1-27 legal guardians at the appropriate time in the immunization
1-28 schedule by the appropriate school. This subsection preempts any
1-29 contrary executive order issued by the governor. This subsection
1-30 expires January 11, 2011.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-32 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-33 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-35 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
