13	(1) the number of children participating in research			
14	programs or studies for the appropriate reporting period;			
15	(2) the type of research program or study in which each			
16	child is participating;			
17	(3) the name of the principal investigator conducting			
18	the research program or study; and			
19	(4) the entity sponsoring the research program or			
20	study.			
21	(c) The commission shall submit a report that contains the			

information in the records kept under Subsection (b) on or before

the 15th day after the last day of the appropriate reporting period

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to the:

2	(2) lieutenant governor;
3	(3) speaker of the house of representatives; and
4	(4) members of the legislature.
5	(d) A report submitted under this section is public
6	information under Chapter 552, Government Code.
7	SECTION 2. This Act applies to a child committed to the
8	Texas Youth Commission without regard to whether the child was
9	committed before, on, or after the effective date of this Act.
10	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
11	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
12	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
13	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
14	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
