A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the filing of birth certificates.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 192.003, Health and Safety Code, is
5	amended by amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsections
6	(f) and (g) to read as follows:
7	(a) The physician or other health care practitioner [7
8	midwife, or person acting as a midwife] in attendance at a birth
9	shall file the birth certificate with the local registrar of the
10	registration district in which the birth occurs.
11	(c) If <u>a health care practitioner is not</u> [there is no
12	physician, midwife, or person acting as a midwife] in attendance at
13	a birth, a person in attendance at the birth shall file the birth
14	certificate. The local registrar of a registration district may not
15	accept a birth certificate filed under this subsection unless the
16	person filing the certificate presents to the registrar:
17	(1) the sworn affidavit of a person in attendance at

- (1) the sworn affidavit of a person in attendance at the birth stating that the child was born in this state; and
- 19 (2) the sworn affidavit of a physician attesting to
 20 the approximate age of the child [and if the birth does not occur in
 21 a hospital or birthing center, the following in the order listed
 22 shall report the birth to the local registrar:
- 23 [(1) the father or mother of the child; or
- 24 [(2) the owner or householder of the premises where

- 1 the birth occurs].
- 2 (f) The department may prescribe the form and contents of
- 3 the affidavits required under Subsection (c).
- 4 (g) In this subsection, "health care practitioner" means an
- 5 <u>individual who holds a license, certificate, registration, title,</u>
- 6 permit, or other authorization that authorizes the individual to
- 7 <u>engage in a health care profession in this state.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 192.003(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 9 repealed.
- 10 SECTION 3. Section 192.003, Health and Safety Code, as
- amended by this Act, applies only to a birth certificate filed on or
- 12 after September 1, 2007. A birth certificate filed before
- 13 September 1, 2007, is governed by the law as it existed immediately
- 14 before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in
- 15 effect for this purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
