## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the purchase of alcoholic beverages by certain holders 3 of a private club registration permit. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Sections 32.08(b) and (c), Alcoholic Beverage 5 6 Code, are amended to read as follows: If the club holding the permit is in <u>a county</u> [an area] 7 (b) where there are no local distributors, alcoholic beverages may be 8 purchased in any county [area] where local distributors are located 9 and may be transported to the club premises if the club also holds a 10 11 beverage cartage permit. The transporter may acquire the alcoholic 12 beverages only on the written order of an officer or manager of the 13 club holding the permit. The alcoholic beverages must be 14 accompanied by a written statement furnished and signed by the local distributor showing the name and address of the consignee and 15 consignor, the origin and destination of the shipment, and any 16 other information required by the commission or administrator. The 17 person in charge of the alcoholic beverages while they are being 18 transported shall exhibit the written statement 19 to any representative of the commission or any peace officer on demand, 20 21 and the statement shall be accepted by the representative or 22 officer as prima facie evidence of the lawful right to transport the 23 alcoholic beverages. (c) If a private club registration permittee holds a 24

beverage cartage permit and the permittee's [his] premises are 1 2 located in a regional airport governed by a board, commission, or 3 authority composed of members from two or more counties, and there is no local distributor at the airport, the private club 4 registration permittee may purchase alcoholic beverages from any 5 6 local distributor in a county wholly or partly located in a trade area served by the airport and transport them to the permittee's 7 8 [his] licensed premises. The transportation of the beverages must be in accordance with Subsection (b) [of this section]. 9
