1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the confidentiality of certain home address information
1-11 in local tax appraisal records regarding current or former peace
1-12 officers and regarding a current or former employee of a
1-13 prosecutor's office or of certain offices with jurisdiction over
1-14 child protective services matters.

1-15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-16 SECTION 1. Section 25.025(a), Tax Code, is amended to read
1-17 as follows:

1-18 (a) This section applies only to:

1-19 (1) a current or former peace officer as defined by
1-20 Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure;

1-21 (2) a county jailer as defined by Section 1701.001,
1-22 Occupations Code;

1-23 (3) an employee of the Texas Department of Criminal
1-24 Justice;

1-25 (4) a commissioned security officer as defined by
1-26 Section 1702.002, Occupations Code; ~~and~~

1-27 (5) a victim of family violence as defined by Section
1-28 71.004, Family Code, if as a result of the act of family violence
1-29 against the victim, the actor is convicted of a felony or a Class A
1-30 misdemeanor; and

1-31 (6) a current or former employee of a district
1-32 attorney, criminal district attorney, or county or municipal
1-33 attorney whose jurisdiction includes any criminal law or child
1-34 protective services matters.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
