A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT
2	relating to enforcement of certain insurance provisions in and
3	related to construction contracts.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 10, Insurance Code, is amended
6	by adding Chapter 1808 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 1808. INSURANCE AND RISK TRANSFER AGREEMENTS IN CERTAIN
8	CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS
9	Sec. 1808.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
10	(1) "Additional insured" means a person covered under
11	another person's insurance policy for an occurrence caused by
12	something other than the sole negligence of the named insured under
13	the policy, or an indemnitor under an indemnification agreement.
14	(2) "Construction contract" means a contract or
15	agreement made or entered into by an owner, contractor,
16	subcontractor, or supplier concerning the construction,
17	alteration, remodeling, repair, or maintenance of a building,
18	structure, appurtenance, or other improvement to or on real
19	property, including moving, demolition, and excavation connected
20	with the real property.
21	(3) "Construction insurance provision" means a

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covenant, promise, agreement, or understanding contained in a

construction contract, or in an agreement collateral to or

affecting a construction contract, that:

- 1 (A) requires a person to provide insurance
- 2 coverage;
- 3 (B) provides insurance coverage; or
- 4 <u>(C) requires insurance coverage for an</u>
- 5 indemnitee under an indemnification agreement.
- 6 Sec. 1808.002. CERTAIN INSURANCE PROVISIONS UNENFORCEABLE.
- 7 (a) A construction insurance provision is void and unenforceable
- 8 to the extent that the provision requires that:
- 9 (1) a person, including an indemnitee under an
- 10 <u>indemnification agreement, be an additional insured; or</u>
- 11 (2) a workers' compensation insurance policy be
- 12 endorsed to provide a waiver of subrogation.
- 13 (b) An insurance policy provision or endorsement that
- 14 provides for an additional insured or a waiver of subrogation in
- 15 contravention of this section is void.
- Sec. 1808.003. WAIVER PROHIBITED. The provisions of this
- 17 chapter may not be waived by contract or otherwise.
- Sec. 1808.004. APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAW. This chapter
- 19 prevails over any other law that conflicts with or is inconsistent
- 20 with this chapter.
- 21 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 22 a contract or agreement entered into on or after the effective date
- 23 of this Act. A contract or agreement entered into before the
- 24 effective date of this Act is governed by the applicable law in
- 25 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
- law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
