A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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1	AN ACT
2	relating to the regulation of fireworks by counties during drought
3	conditions; providing a criminal penalty.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 352.051(a)(1), Local Government Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(1) "Restricted fireworks" means any composition or
8	device designed for entertainment to produce a visible or audible
9	effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration, or detonation [only
10	those items classified under 49 C.F.R. Sec. 173.100 (r)(2) (10-1-86
11	edition), as "skyrockets with sticks" and "missiles with fins"].

- 12 SECTION 2. Section 352.051, Local Government Code, is 13 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 14 (a-1) This section does not apply to:
- (1) toy pistols, toy canes, toy guns, or other devices
 that use paper or plastic caps in sheets, strips, rolls, or
 individual caps containing not more than an average of 25/100 of a
 grain of explosive composition for each cap and that are packed and
 shipped according to 49 C.F.R. Part 173 (1996);
- 20 (2) model rockets and model rocket motors designed,
 21 sold, and used for the purpose of propelling recoverable aero
 22 models;
- 23 (3) propelling or expelling charges consisting of a 24 mixture of sulfur, charcoal, and potassium nitrate;

- 1 (4) novelties and trick noisemakers; 2 (5) the sale, at wholesale, of any type of fireworks by
- a resident manufacturer, distributor, importer, or jobber if the 3
- fireworks are intended for shipment directly out of state in 4
- 5 accordance with the regulations of the United States Department of
- 6 Transportation;
- 7 (6) the sale, and use in emergency situations, of
- 8 pyrotechnic signaling devices or distress signals for marine,
- aviation, or highway use; 9
- 10 (7) the use of fusee and railway torpedoes by
- 11 railroads;
- 12 (8) the sale of blank cartridges for use in radio,
- television, film, or theater productions, for signal or ceremonial 13
- 14 purposes in athletic events, or for industrial purposes;
- 15 (9) the use of any pyrotechnic device by military
- 16 organizations; or
- (10) a public fireworks display conducted by a 17
- licensed pyrotechnic operator. 18
- SECTION 3. An order adopted by a commissioners court under 19
- Section 352.051, Local Government Code, before the effective date 20
- 21 of this Act applies only to the sale or use of fireworks defined as
- restricted fireworks under Section 352.051, Local Government Code, 22
- 23 when the order was adopted.
- 24 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 26
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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1 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
