- 2 relating to the imposition of a surcharge for use of a credit card

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 339.001, Finance Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) In a sale of goods or services, a seller may not impose a
- 9 surcharge on a buyer who uses a credit card for an extension of
- 10 credit instead of cash, a check, or a similar means of payment
- 11 unless:
- 12 <u>(1)</u> before the sale the seller has disclosed the
- 13 <u>surcharge to the buyer;</u>
- 14 (2) the amount of the sale, before including the
- 15 surcharge, does not exceed \$10; and
- 16 (3) the surcharge does not exceed \$1.
- 17 (d) A surcharge for an in-person transaction may be
- disclosed, as required by Subsection (a), by posting a notice of the
- 19 surcharge in a conspicuous location.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
