## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the eligibility of certain transfer students for a
3	TEXAS grant.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "Ladders to
6	College Success Act."
7	SECTION 2. Subchapter M, Chapter 56, Education Code, is
8	amended by adding Section 56.3051 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 56.3051. ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN TRANSFER STUDENTS TO
10	RECEIVE TEXAS GRANTS. (a) A person who otherwise meets the
11	requirements of Section 56.305 but who has not previously received
12	a TEXAS grant may receive a TEXAS grant under that section as if the
13	person had previously qualified for and received an initial TEXAS
14	grant if the person:
15	(1) qualified for a Texas Educational Opportunity
16	Grant under Subchapter P in the last semester or term the person
17	attended an eligible institution for purposes of Subchapter P,
18	without regard to whether the person received a grant under
19	Subchapter P; and
20	(2) meets either of the following academic
21	requirements:
22	(A) received an associate degree from an
23	institution of higher education not earlier than May 1, 2001; or

(B) completed the core curriculum at an

- 1 <u>institution of higher education.</u>
- 2 (b) The total number of semester credit hours, or the
- 3 equivalent, for which the person may receive a Texas Educational
- 4 Opportunity Grant or a TEXAS grant may not exceed the total number
- of hours for which a student not covered by this section may receive
- 6 a TEXAS grant under Section 56.304(d).
- 7 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act relating to
- 8 the eligibility of a student for a TEXAS grant applies beginning
- 9 with grants awarded for the 2007-2008 academic year. Grants
- awarded for an academic year before the 2007-2008 academic year are
- 11 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 12 of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 13 purpose.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
