- workforce, may appeal the decision by bringing a cause of action

- 15 <u>(b) An individual who prevails in a suit brought by the</u> 16 individual under this section is entitled to:

- SECTION 2. Section 657.010, Government Code, as added by this Act, applies only to an employment decision made by a public entity or a public work to which Chapter 657, Government Code, applies, on or after the effective date of this Act. An employment
