Chapter 544, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 544.0075 to read as follows: 7 8 Sec. 544.0075. CERTAIN TRAFFIC-ACTUATED ELECTRIC TRAFFIC-CONTROL SIGNALS. (a) This section applies only to a 9 traffic-actuated electric traffic-control signal that consists of 10 11 a traffic-control signal for which the intervals vary according to 12 the demands of vehicular traffic as registered by a detector and 13 that is installed and operating at an intersection. 14 (b) In addition to any other type of vehicle the presence of which the detector for the traffic-actuated electric 15 traffic-control signal may register, the detector 16 traffic-actuated electric traffic-control device to which this 17 18 section applies must be capable of registering the presence of a 19 motorcycle. SECTION 2. Section 544.0075, Transportation Code, as added 20 21 by this Act, applies only to a detector that is installed, replaced, 22 calibrated, or recalibrated in connection with a traffic-actuated

electric traffic-control signal on or after the effective date of
