- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 571.133(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 5 are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) To appeal a final decision of the commission, the
- 7 complainant, if any, the respondent, or the party's agent [a
- 8 person] may file a petition in a district court in Travis County or
- 9 in the county in which the respondent resides.
- 10 (b) The petition must be filed not later than the 30th
- 11 business day after the date the party [person] received the
- 12 decision.
- 13 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to a proceeding under Subchapter E, Chapter 571, Government Code,
- 15 with respect to which a preliminary review was begun on or after
- 16 September 1, 2007. A proceeding under Subchapter E, Chapter 571,
- 17 Government Code, with respect to which a preliminary review was
- begun before September 1, 2007, is governed by the law as it existed
- 19 immediately before that date, and that law is continued in effect
- 20 for that purpose.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
