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- 2 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2007, the Texas 3 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules 4 necessary to implement the changes in law made by this Act.
- SECTION 4. Notwithstanding Section 2052.107, Occupations Code, as added by this Act, a person is not required to hold an event coordinator license or registration to act as a combative sports
