7	Sec. 43.083. CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES TO DISANNEX LAND OWNED
8	BY NAVIGATION DISTRICT. (a) A municipality with a population of
9	less than 30,000, that is in a county that borders the Gulf of
10	Mexico and that is adjacent to a county with a population of one
11	million or more, and that, before the effective date of this Act and
12	without the consent of the district, annexed land owned by a
13	navigation district operating under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas
14	Constitution, shall, not later than January 1, 2008, disannex the
15	land unless the district notifies the municipality in writing that
16	the district elects that the land not be disannexed.
17	(b) A municipality that disannexes land under Subsection
18	(a) and that, on the effective date of this section, provides
19	utility services to customers on that land shall continue to
20	provide the services at the same rate until the first anniversary of
21	the effective date of this section.
22	(c) This section expires January 1, 2010.
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
