A municipality with a population of less than 30,000, that is in a county that borders the Gulf of 9 Mexico and that is adjacent to a county with a population of one 10 million or more, and that seeks to annex land owned by a navigation 11 12 district operating under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas 13 Constitution, must have the consent of the district to annex the 14 land. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 19
