1	AN ACT
2	relating to the pilot program providing for reduced undergraduate
3	tuition during a term of the summer session at Texas A&M University.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 54.0516(a), (b), (d), and (e),
6	Education Code, are amended to read as follows:
7	(a) This section applies only to a resident undergraduate
8	student enrolled for a <u>term of the</u> summer [term or] session at Texas
9	A&M University.
10	(b) Tuition, other than tuition under Section 54.0513,
11	charged to a student to whom this section applies is three-fourths
12	of the amount otherwise provided by this subchapter, except that a
13	student to whom this section applies may receive a reduction in
14	tuition under this section for not more than one term of the summer
15	session of not more than six weeks.
16	(d) This section applies only if the legislature
17	specifically appropriates money to Texas A&M University for the
18	state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2009 [2007], to cover the
19	tuition revenue lost to the institution by the application of this
20	section.
21	(e) This section applies only to a <u>term of the</u> summer [term

22 or] session in <u>2008</u> [2006 or 2007]. This section expires January 1, 23 <u>2009</u> [2008].

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
