4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter N, Chapter 242, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 242.6015 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 242.6015. LIMIT ON FILLING PRESCRIPTIONS. Before ar
8	institution may fill a prescription for a resident of the
9	institution, the institution shall determine whether the patient is
10	covered by a health insurance policy or other private health
11	benefit plan that provides prescription drug benefits, including
12	coverage provided in accordance with Medicare Part D, that would
13	cover the prescribed medication. If the resident has coverage for
14	prescription drug benefits, the institution may fill the
15	<pre>prescription only if:</pre>
16	(1) the institution:
17	(A) is a network provider under the resident's
18	policy or plan; or
19	(B) receives written authorization from the
20	resident or the resident's legally authorized representative to
21	fill the prescription; or
22	(2) it is immediately necessary to administer the
23	prescribed medication to prevent imminent probable death or
24	substantial bodily harm to the resident.

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
