	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to the education of children attending charter schools
3	that the commissioner of education proposes to close.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 12, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 12.1165 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 12.1165. TRANSITION SERVICES FOR STUDENTS ON
8	REVOCATION, DENIAL, OR SURRENDER OF CHARTER. (a) If the
9	commissioner revokes or denies the renewal of a charter of an
10	open-enrollment charter school, or if an open-enrollment charter
11	school surrenders its charter, the commissioner must ensure that
12	the students enrolled at the school remain in an educational
13	setting by:
14	(1) arranging for the placement of each student in
15	another public school;
16	(2) ensuring that each student with special needs,
17	including a student receiving special education services under
18	Subchapter A, Chapter 29, or a student who is pregnant or a parent,
19	continues to receive the appropriate services; and
20	(3) arranging for transportation services to the new
21	school for each student.
22	(b) The commissioner shall provide written notice to the
23	students and the parents and guardians of the students in the school
24	<u>of:</u>

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1	(1) the revocation, denial of renewal, or surrender of
2	the school's charter; and
3	(2) the commissioner's duty to assist the students in
4	meeting their educational needs.
5	(c) If the local juvenile probation department or the Texas
6	Youth Commission has a role in supervising a student enrolled at the
7	school, the commissioner shall notify the applicable entity of the
8	placement of the student in another school under this section.
9	(d) The commissioner shall adopt rules to implement this
10	section. The rules must require the commissioner to maintain a
11	record of where students enrolled at the school are placed after the
12	school is ordered closed.
13	SECTION 2. The commissioner of education shall adopt rules
14	as required by Section 12.1165, Education Code, as added by this
15	Act, as soon as practicable after the effective date of this Act.
16	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
17	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
18	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
19	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
20	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
