1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the name of Sam Houston State University.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 96.61, Education Code, is amended to
1-12 read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 96.61. SAM HOUSTON STATE UNIVERSITY. (a) Sam Houston
1-14 State University is a coeducational institution of higher education
1-15 located in the city of Huntsville. It is under the management and
1-16 control of the Board of Regents, Texas State University System.

1-17 (b) The board may not change the name of the university.

1-18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-22 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
