- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.969 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.969. PRESERVING INSTITUTION NAME BASED ON STATE
- 9 HISTORICAL FIGURE. (a) In this section, "governing board" and
- 10 "institution of higher education" have the meanings assigned by
- 11 Section 61.003.
- 12 (b) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 13 <u>maintain a registry that includes each institution of higher</u>
- 14 education that is named after an established historical figure of
- this state, as determined by the coordinating board in consultation
- 16 with the Texas Historical Commission.
- 17 (c) The governing board of an institution of higher
- 18 education included on the registry may not change the name of the
- 19 <u>institution in a manner that removes the name of the established</u>
- 20 <u>historical figure from the name of the institution.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
