5	SECTION 1. Chapter 68, Education Code, is amended by adding
6	Subchapter B to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER B. POWERS AND DUTIES OF BOARD
8	Sec. 68.21. SUSTAINABLE WATER SUPPLY RESEARCH CENTER. (a)
9	In this section, "center" means the Sustainable Water Supply
10	Research Center.
11	(b) The board may establish and operate the Sustainable
12	Water Supply Research Center as part of The University of Texas at
13	Arlington.
14	(c) If established, the center shall:
15	(1) conduct, sponsor, or direct multidisciplinary
16	research directed toward:
17	(A) developing sustainable water supplies for
18	this state; and
19	(B) mitigating the effect of diminishing water
20	supplies on the economy and people of this state; and
21	(2) conduct a comprehensive, interdisciplinary
22	instructional program in sustainable water development at the
23	graduate level and offer undergraduate courses for students

- 1 (d) The organization, control, and management of the center
- 2 <u>are vested in the board.</u>
- 3 (e) The center may enter into an agreement or may cooperate
- 4 with a public or private entity to perform the research functions of
- 5 the center.
- 6 (f) The board may solicit, accept, and administer gifts and
- 7 grants from any public or private source for the use and benefit of
- 8 the center.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
