5	SECTION 1. Chapter 68, Education Code, is amended by adding
6	Subchapter B to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER B. POWERS AND DUTIES OF BOARD
8	Sec. 68.21. SUSTAINABLE WATER SUPPLY RESEARCH CENTER. (a)
9	In this section, "center" means the Sustainable Water Supply
10	Research Center.
11	(b) The board shall operate the Sustainable Water Supply
12	Research Center as part of The University of Texas at Arlington.
13	(c) The center shall:
14	(1) conduct, sponsor, or direct multidisciplinary
15	research directed toward:
16	(A) developing sustainable water supplies for
17	this state; and
18	(B) mitigating the effect of diminishing water
19	supplies on the economy and people of this state; and
20	(2) conduct a comprehensive, interdisciplinary
21	instructional program in sustainable water development at the
22	graduate level and offer undergraduate courses for students
23	interested in sustainable water development.
24	(d) The organization, control, and management of the center

1 are vested in the board.

2 (e) The center may enter into an agreement or may cooperate

3 with a public or private entity to perform the research functions of 4 the center.

5 (f) The board may solicit, accept, and administer gifts and 6 grants from any public or private source for the use and benefit of 7 the center.

8 SECTION 2. The board of regents of The University of Texas 9 System shall establish the Sustainable Water Supply Research Center 10 as provided by Section 68.21, Education Code, as added by this Act, 11 not later than September 1, 2008.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
