9	dispense a drug for immunosuppressive therapy following transplant
10	unless the drug is the specific formulation and manufactured by the

12 physician. (b) A pharmacist may substitute a drug product that is generically equivalent for immunosuppressive therapy following 14 transplant only if, before making the substitution, the pharmacist obtains a signed authorization from the prescribing physician.
