On the 61st day after 10 11 election day, the general custodian of election records may: 12 (1) require a person who has possession of a key that 13 operates the lock on a ballot box containing voted ballots to return 14 the key to the custodian; and (2) unlock the ballot box and transfer the voted 15 ballots to another secure container for the remainder of the 16 preservation period. 17 (b-1) Except as permitted by this code, a ballot box or other 18 secure container containing voted ballots may not be opened during 19 20 the preservation period. 21 If during the preservation period an authorized entry is 22 made into a ballot box or other secure container containing voted ballots, when the purpose for the entry is fulfilled, the box or 23

container shall be relocked or resecured, and the box and key or

- 1 <u>secure container</u> returned to the custodian.
- 2 (d) A custodian of a ballot box or secure container
- 3 containing voted ballots commits an offense if, during the
- 4 preservation period prescribed by Subsection (a), the custodian:
- 5 (1) makes an unauthorized entry into the box or
- 6 container; or
- 7 (2) fails to prevent another person from handling the
- 8 box or container in an unauthorized manner or from making an
- 9 unauthorized entry into the box or container.
- SECTION 2. Section 66.058(g), Election Code, is repealed.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 16 legislative session.
