(a) The [As designated by the commissioner, division staff, 8 other than the] benefit review officer who presides [presided or 9 will preside] at the benefit review conference $[\tau]$ shall: 10 (1) consider a written or verbal request for 11 an 12 interlocutory order for the payment of benefits; and 13 (2) [shall issue an interlocutory order] the if 14 benefit review officer determines that issuance of an interlocutory order is [determined to be] appropriate, issue the interlocutory 15 order not later than the third day after the date of receipt of the 16 request under Subdivision (1). 17 (b) The interlocutory order may address accrued benefits, 18 future benefits, or both accrued benefits and future benefits. 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 20 21 to a request for an interlocutory order made in conjunction with a 22 workers' compensation benefit review conference that is conducted by a benefit review officer on or after the effective date of this 23 Act. A request made before that date is governed by the law in 24

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1 effect on the date the request is made, and the former law is 2 continued in effect for that purpose.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
