8	allowed by federal law, the department shall exclude from the
9	monthly income and resources of an applicant for nutritional
10	assistance an amount equal to the average amount charged for
11	electric utility service that is billed in the applicant's name for
12	the applicant's residence during the three months preceding the
13	date of the application for purposes of determining:
14	(1) whether the applicant meets household income and
15	resource requirements for eligibility for nutritional assistance;
16	or
17	(2) the amount of assistance or the types of other
18	benefits for which the applicant is eligible under a nutritional

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a determination of eligibility of a person for nutritional assistance under Chapter 33, Human Resources Code, made on or after

- 6 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 7 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

- 10 waiver or authorization is granted.
