SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to the punishment for an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. The punishment for an offense committed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was committed before the effective date.
