1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to standing for certain individuals to file a suit
1-9 affecting the parent-child relationship.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 102.006, Family Code, is amended by
1-12 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
1-13 follows:

1-14 (a) Except as provided by Subsections [~~Subsection~~] (b) and
1-15 (c), if the parent-child relationship between the child and every
1-16 living parent of the child has been terminated, an original suit may
1-17 not be filed by:

1-18 (1) a former parent whose parent-child relationship
1-19 with the child has been terminated by court order;

1-20 (2) the father of the child; or

1-21 (3) a family member or relative by blood, adoption, or
1-22 marriage of either a former parent whose parent-child relationship
1-23 has been terminated or of the father of the child.

1-24 (c) The limitations on filing suit imposed by this section
1-25 do not apply to an adult sibling of the child, a grandparent of the
1-26 child, an aunt who is a sister of a parent of the child, or an uncle
1-27 who is a brother of a parent of the child if the adult sibling,
1-28 grandparent, aunt, or uncle files an original suit or a suit for
1-29 modification requesting managing conservatorship of the child not
1-30 later than the 90th day after the date the parent-child
1-31 relationship between the child and the parent is terminated in a
1-32 suit filed by the Department of Family and Protective Services
1-33 requesting the termination of the parent-child relationship.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
