3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subtitle H, Title 3, Education Code, is amended
5	by adding Chapter 155 to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 155. STEM CELL RESEARCH PROGRAM
7	Sec. 155.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
8	(1) "Coordinating board" has the meaning assigned by
9	<u>Section 141.001.</u>
10	(2) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning
11	assigned by Section 61.003.
12	(3) "Program" means the stem cell research program
13	established under this chapter.
14	Sec. 155.002. ADMINISTRATION; GUIDELINES AND
15	PROCEDURES. (a) The coordinating board shall administer the
16	<pre>program to:</pre>
17	(1) make grants and loans to institutions of higher
18	education and advanced medical research facilities in this state
19	<u>for:</u>
20	(A) stem cell research;
21	(B) facilities for stem cell research; and
22	(C) other vital research opportunities to
23	develop therapies, protocols, or medical procedures that will

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result in, as speedily as possible, the cure for, or substantial

- 1 mitigation of, major diseases, injuries, and orphan diseases;
- 2 (2) support institutions of higher education and
- 3 <u>advanced medical research facilities in this state that receive</u>
- 4 grants under the program in all stages of the process of developing
- 5 cures using regenerative medicine, from laboratory research
- 6 through successful clinical trials;
- 7 (3) establish the appropriate regulatory standards
- 8 and oversight bodies for stem cell research and facilities
- 9 development at institutions and facilities that receive grants
- 10 under the program; and
- 11 (4) assist potential candidates for grants under the
- 12 program in the grant application process.
- 13 (b) The coordinating board shall develop research
- 14 priorities, guidelines, and procedures for the selection of
- 15 specific projects at institutions of higher education and advanced
- 16 medical research facilities.
- 17 (c) The guidelines and procedures developed by the
- 18 coordinating board must provide for awards on a competitive, peer
- 19 review basis for specific projects at institutions of higher
- 20 education and advanced medical research facilities.
- 21 Sec. 155.003. FUNDING. The program may be funded by:
- 22 <u>(1) appropriations; or</u>
- 23 (2) gifts, grants, and donations made for that
- 24 purpose.
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
