7	Sec. 105.10. OPERATING HOURS IN CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES.
8	(a) The governing body of a municipality with a population of 1.9
9	million or more may enact an ordinance that prohibits an
10	establishment licensed or permitted under this code for the
11	on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages, other than an
12	establishment holding a food and beverage certificate whose primary
13	business being operated on the premises is food service, from
14	operating except:
15	(1) during the hours during which alcoholic beverages
16	may be consumed on the premises under this chapter; or
17	(2) during other hours specified by the ordinance so
18	long as those hours do not begin later or end earlier than the hours
19	during which alcoholic beverages may be consumed on the premises

- 21 (b) An ordinance adopted under this section does not affect
- 22 the hours during which alcoholic beverages may be sold or consumed
- 23 <u>on a licensed or permitted premises.</u>
- 24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
