A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the creation of a submersion injury and drowning
3	prevention database.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 92, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 92.012 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 92.012. SUBMERSION INJURY AND DROWNING PREVENTION
8	DATABASE. (a) The department shall collect and analyze information
9	related to submersion injuries and drowning at the state and
10	regional level, and to the extent feasible, at the local level. The
11	department shall obtain the information in the manner required by
12	other state law and may obtain additional information from federal
13	agencies or private and public organizations. The department shall
14	maintain a database of this information.
15	(b) The database may include:
16	(1) information related to risk factors identified for
17	submersion injuries and drowning;
18	(2) morbidity and mortality rates for submersion
19	injuries and drowning; and
20	(3) community indicators relevant to submersion
21	injuries and drowning.
22	(c) In compiling the database, the department may use

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information available from other sources, such as reports of

hospital discharge data, information included in death

- 1 certificates, or information previously collected by the
- 2 department.
- 3 (d) The department may identify additional information to
- 4 be included in the database. To the extent that information is
- 5 available, the department may collect the information and include
- 6 the information in the database.
- 7 <u>(e) The department shall make the information in the</u>
- 8 database available to the public in a manner designed to inform the
- 9 public on a local, regional, and statewide basis of:
- 10 (1) the risk factors associated with submersion
- 11 injuries and drowning; and
- 12 (2) preventative measures that may reduce the risk of
- 13 submersion injury and drowning.
- 14 (f) Information obtained by the department under this
- 15 section that identifies an individual or that is otherwise
- 16 confidential under law is confidential, is excepted from required
- 17 public disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code, and may not
- 18 be disclosed for any purpose.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
