7	Sec. 42.14. ILLUMINATION OF AIRCRAFT BY INTENSE LIGHT. (a)
8	A person commits an offense if:
9	(1) the person intentionally directs a light from a
10	laser pointer or other light source at an aircraft; and
11	(2) the light has an intensity sufficient to impair
12	the operator's ability to control the aircraft.
13	(b) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under this
14	section that the actor was using the light to send an emergency
15	<u>distress signal.</u>
16	(c) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor
17	unless the intensity of the light impairs the operator's ability to
18	control the aircraft, in which event the offense is a Class A
19	misdemeanor.
20	(d) If conduct that constitutes an offense under this
21	section also constitutes an offense under any other law, the actor
22	may be prosecuted under this section or the other law.
23	(e) In this section, "laser pointer" has the meaning
24	assigned by Section 42.13.
