- A person commits an offense if: 8
- (1) the person intentionally directs a light from a 9
- laser pointer or other light source at an aircraft; and 10
- (2) the light has an intensity sufficient to impair 11
- 12 the operator's ability to control the aircraft.
- 13 (b) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under this
- 14 section that the actor was using the light to send an emergency
- 15 distress signal.
- (c) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor 16
- unless the intensity of the light impairs the operator's ability to 17
- 18 control the aircraft, in which event the offense is a Class A
- misdemeanor. 19
- (d) If conduct that constitutes an offense under this 20
- 21 section also constitutes an offense under any other law, the actor
- may be prosecuted under this section or the other law. 22
- (e) In this section, "laser pointer" has the meaning 23
- 24 assigned by Section 42.13.
