4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 39.023, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (1-1) to read as follows:
7	(1-1) Subsection (1) does not apply to a student enrolled in
8	an English language immersion program. A student enrolled in an
9	English language immersion program must be assessed using
10	assessment instruments in English under Subsection (a). A school
11	district may apply to the commissioner for a waiver under which the
12	performance of a student in an English language immersion program
13	on an assessment instrument in English under Subsection (a) is
14	excluded for not more than two consecutive years for purposes of
15	determining the performance rating under Section 39.072 of the
16	district or of the campus the student attends. The student's
17	performance during the period covered by the waiver may be included
18	in the assessment system developed under Section 39.027(e), but may
19	not be included in the academic excellence indicator system under
20	Section 39.051, the campus report card under Section 39.052, the
21	performance report under Section 39.053, and the comprehensive
22	annual report under Section 39.182.
23	SECTION 2. Section 39.027, Education Code, is amended by

24 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

(a-1) The exemptions under Subsections (a)(3) and (4) do not 1 2 apply to a student enrolled in an English language immersion 3 program. 4 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008 5 school year. SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9

10 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
