A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Sections 33.154 and 33.155, Education Code, are
5	amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 33.154. DUTIES OF <u>COMMISSIONER</u> [STATE DIRECTOR]. (a)
7	The commissioner [state director] shall:
8	(1) coordinate the efforts of the Communities In
9	Schools program with other social service organizations and
10	agencies and with public school personnel to provide services to
11	students who are at risk of dropping out of school or engaging in
12	delinquent conduct, including students who are in family conflict
13	or emotional crisis;
14	(2) set standards for the Communities In Schools
15	program and establish state performance goals, objectives, and
16	measures for the program, including performance goals, objectives,
17	and measures that consider improvement in student:
18	(A) behavior;
19	(B) academic achievement; and
20	(C) promotion, graduation, retention, and
21	<pre>dropout rates;</pre>
22	(3) obtain information to determine accomplishment of
23	state performance goals, objectives, and measures;

(4) promote and market the program in communities in

- which the program is not established;
- 2 (5) help communities that want to participate in the
- 3 program establish a local funding base; [and]
- 4 (6) provide training and technical assistance for
- 5 participating communities and programs; and
- 6 (7) adopt policies concerning:

- 24 program to compete through a competitive bidding process to receive

- 1 the department, and Communities In Schools, Inc. shall work
- 2 together to maximize the effectiveness of the Communities In
- 3 Schools program.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 42.152, Education Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subsection (u) to read as follows:
- 6 (u) From the total amount of funds appropriated for
- 7 allotments under this section, the commissioner shall, each fiscal
- 8 year, withhold an amount to be determined by the commissioner, but
- 9 not less than \$30 million for prekindergarten through high school
- 10 programs under Subchapter E, Chapter 33, and distribute that amount
- 11 as provided by Section 33.156. After deducting the amount withheld
- 12 under this subsection from the total amount appropriated for the
- 13 allotment under Subsection (a), the commissioner shall reduce each
- 14 district's tier one allotments in the same manner described for a
- 15 reduction in allotments under Section 42.253 and shall allocate
- 16 funds to each district accordingly.
- 17 SECTION 3. Sections 33.151(1), 33.153, and 33.155(b) and
- 18 (c), Education Code, are repealed.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
