Section 15(a)(1), Article 42.12, Code of 7 Criminal Procedure, is amended to read as follows: (1) On conviction of a state jail felony under Section 8 481.115(b), 481.1151(b)(1), 481.116(b), 481.121(b)(3), 9 or 481.129(g)(1), Health and Safety Code, that is punished under 10 11 Section 12.35(a), Penal Code, the judge shall suspend the 12 imposition of the sentence and place the defendant on community supervision, unless the defendant has previously been convicted of 13 14 a felony, other than a felony punished under Section 12.44(a), Penal Code, or unless the conviction resulted from an adjudication 15 of the guilt of a defendant previously placed on deferred 16 adjudication community supervision for the offense, in which event 17 the judge may suspend the imposition of the sentence and place the 18 defendant on community supervision or may order the sentence to be 19 executed. The provisions of this subdivision requiring the judge 20 21 to suspend the imposition of the sentence and place the defendant on community supervision do not apply to a defendant who under Section 22 23 481.1151(b)(1), Health and Safety Code, possessed more than five 24 abuse units of the controlled substance or under Section

3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 4 to a defendant who is convicted of a state jail felony on or after 5 the effective date of this Act. A defendant convicted before the 6 effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect on the 7 date of the conviction, and the former law is continued in effect 8 for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
