(4) the establishment and use of a columbarium on the 1 2 campus of a private or independent institution of higher education, as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code, that is wholly or 3 substantially controlled, managed, owned, or supported by or 4 otherwise affiliated with an organized religious society or sect 5 6 that is exempt from income taxation under Section 501(a), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, by being listed under Section 501(c)(3) of 7 that code, if a place of worship is located on the campus. 8
