1-8 relating to the reporting of certain grievances by school district  
1-9 employees.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 11, Education Code, is  
1-12 amended by adding Section 11.171 to read as follows:

1-13 Sec. 11.171. SCHOOL DISTRICT GRIEVANCE POLICY. A school  
1-14 district grievance policy must permit a school district employee to  
1-15 report a grievance against a supervisor that alleges the  
1-16 supervisor's violation of the law in the workplace or the  
1-17 supervisor's unlawful harassment of the employee to a supervisor  
1-18 other than the supervisor against whom the employee intends to  
1-19 report the grievance.

1-20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
