## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to the determination of eligibility for Medicaid for

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 32.026, Human Resources Code, is amended

6 by adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:

(d-1) In adopting rules under this section, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall, to the extent allowed by federal law, develop and implement an expedited process for determining eligibility for and enrollment in the medical assistance program for a person who is on active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States or the state military forces, or the spouse or dependent of that person. The process developed under this subsection must allow a person who

presents the person's military identification and proof that the

person was enrolled in the Medicaid program in another state to

receive treatment through the medical assistance program

18 <u>immediately.</u>

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19 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act

a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a

21 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,

22 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or

23 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the

24 waiver or authorization is granted.
