A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the certification of eligibility for Medicaid for

3 certain persons in the armed forces and their family members.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 32.026, Human Resources Code, is amended

6 by adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:

- 7 (d-1) In adopting rules under this section, the executive
- 8 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 9 ensure, to the extent allowed by federal law, that documentation
- 10 and verification procedures used in determining and certifying the
- 11 eligibility and need for medical assistance of a person who is on
- 12 active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States or
- 13 the state military forces, or of the spouse or dependent of that
- 14 person, are expedited in the same manner as the documentation and
- 15 verification procedures used to determine and certify the
- 16 <u>eligibility of a person for emergency medical assist</u>ance are
- 17 <u>expedited.</u>
- 18 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 19 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 20 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 21 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 22 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 23 waiver or authorization is granted.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
