1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to enforcement of commercial motor vehicle safety
1-10 standards in certain municipalities.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 644.101(b), Transportation Code, is
1-13 amended to read as follows:

1-14 (b) A police officer of any of the following municipalities
1-15 is eligible to apply for certification under this section:

1-16 (1) a municipality with a population of 100,000 or
1-17 more;

1-18 (2) a municipality with a population of 25,000 or more
1-19 any part of which is located in a county with a population of two
1-20 million or more;

1-21 (3) a municipality with a population of less than
1-22 25,000:

1-23 (A) any part of which is located in a county with
1-24 a population of 2.4 million; and

1-25 (B) that contains or is adjacent to an
1-26 international port; ~~or~~

1-27 (4) a municipality any part of which is located in a
1-28 county bordering the United Mexican States; or

1-29 (5) a municipality with a population of less than
1-30 5,000 that is located:

1-31 (A) adjacent to a bay connected to the Gulf of
1-32 Mexico; and

1-33 (B) in a county adjacent to a county with a
1-34 population greater than 3.3 million.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
