24	(3) information described by Subdivision (1) or (2)

2 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed 3 4 before the effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect at the time the offense was committed, and the former law is 5 6 continued in effect for that purpose. For the purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this 7 Act if any element of the offense was committed before that date. 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 9
