- SECTION 3. Section 12.104(b), Education Code, as amended by this Act, and Section 42.005(h), Education Code, as added by this Act, apply beginning with the 2007-2008 school year.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
