- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 130, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 130.910 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 130.910. NONBINDING REFERENDUM ON COUNTY FISCAL
- 8 MATTER. (a) The commissioners court of a county may hold a
- 9 nonbinding referendum in the county on any question affecting a
- 10 county fiscal matter other than a matter involving:
- 11 (1) a labor agreement; or
- 12 (2) compensation of any county employee.
- 13 (b) The referendum shall be held in the same manner as an
- 14 election on a county measure and must take place on an election date
- authorized by Section 41.001, Election Code.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
