- 3 (B) in a fenced yard or patio maintained by the

- 7 operate at not less than 90 percent of its rated efficiency.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 202.008, Property Code, as added by this
- 9 Act, applies to a dedicatory instrument without regard to whether
- 10 the dedicatory instrument takes effect or is renewed before, on, or
- 11 after the effective date of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
