 - (b) An appraisal district, taxing unit, or tax assessor or collector that posts appraisal record information on the Internet must provide notice on the main Internet site that provides an Internet user with the means to search or access the information of a property owner's right to prohibit online disclosure of the owner's name in connection with property included in the appraisal records and the procedure for prohibiting disclosure of that information.
- 22 <u>(c) A choice made under Subsection (a) remains valid until</u> 23 rescinded in writing by the owner.
