4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2, Chapter 572, Acts of the 79th
6	Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, is amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2. BOUNDARIES. <u>The</u> [ <del>As of the effective date of this</del>
8	Act, the] Airline Improvement District includes all territory
9	contained in the following described area:
10	GENERAL BOUNDARIES: THE DISTRICT IS LOCATED WITHIN HARRIS
11	COUNTY, TEXAS, BEING GENERALLY BOUNDED WESTERLY BY SWEETWATER LANE
12	AND THE CITY OF HOUSTON LIMITS, BOUNDED NORTHERLY BY WEST ROAD,
13	BEING THE CITY OF HOUSTON LIMITS AND ALONG AND INCLUDING ALL OF THE
14	PROPERTIES WITH AN ADDRESS ON AIRLINE DRIVE AND ALDINE MAIL ROAD,
15	BOUNDED EASTERLY BY THE HARDY TOLL ROAD AND THE CITY OF HOUSTON
16	LIMITS, AND BOUNDED SOUTHERLY BY CARBY ROAD AND CANINO STREET,
17	BEING THE CITY OF HOUSTON LIMITS.
18	LOCATED in parts or all of the George Green Survey, Abstract
19	281, the D.C. Giddings Survey, Abstract 898, the C. Walter Survey,
20	Abstract 849, the J. Hopkins Survey, Abstract 334, the D. Hacker
21	Survey, Abstract 1314, Phil Tharp Survey, Abstract 1645, the A. C.
22	Allen Survey, Abstract 1295, the M.K. Snell Survey, Abstract 688,
23	the T. A. Manefee Survey, Abstract 565, the T. Nellis Survey,
24	Abstract 604, the G. Sultzbaugh Survey, Abstract 747, the S.G.

1	Powell Survey, Abstract 636, the J. E. Durkee Survey, Abstract

14	Houston limits to the easterly right-of-way line of Airline Drive;
15	THENCE, in a southeasterly direction, 0.9 mile, more or less,
16	along the easterly right-of-way line of Airline Drive and including
17	the properties with the addresses on Airline Drive to the
18	intersection of the northerly right-of-way line of Aldine Mail
19	Road;
20	THENCE, in an easterly direction, 1.5 miles, more or less,
21	along the northerly right-of-way line of Aldine Mail Road, and
22	including the properties with the addresses on Aldine Mail Road to
23	the intersection of the westerly right-of-way line of the Hardy
24	Toll Road;
25	THENCE, in a southeasterly direction, 0.7 mile, more or less,
26	along the westerly right-of-way line of the Hardy Toll Road to the
27	centerline of Halls Bayou and the City of Houston limits;

No. 1694 THENCE, in a westerly direction, 30 feet, more or less, along 1 2 the centerline of Halls Bayou and the City of Houston limits to the westerly right-of-way line of a 30 foot drainage ditch easement, 3 4 being an angle point in the City of Houston limits; 5 THENCE, in a southwesterly direction, 0.2 mile, more or less, 6 along the westerly right-of-way line of said 30 foot drainage ditch 7 easement and the City of Houston limits to the intersection with the northerly extension of the east line of the S.G. Powell 11 12 Survey and the City of Houston limits, crossing Gulf Bank Road, and continuing to the northeast corner of the S.G. Powell Survey; 13 THENCE, in a westerly direction, 0.2 mile, more or less, 14 15 along the north line of the S.G. Powell Survey and the City of 16 Houston limits to the northwest corner of Melrose Park Subdivision, 17 Section Six; THENCE, in a southerly direction, 0.18 mile, more or less, 18 along the west line of Melrose Park Subdivision, Section Six and the 19 20 City of <u>Houston limits</u>, passing the southwest corner of Melrose 21 Park Subdivision, Section Six to a point in the southerly 22 right-of-way line of Mitchell Road; THENCE, in a westerly direction, 20 feet, more or less, along 23 24 the southerly right-of-way line of Mitchell Road and the City of 25 Houston limits to the northwest corner of Melrose Park Subdivision, 26 Section Three; 27 THENCE, in a southerly direction, 0.16 mile, more or less,

along the west line of Melrose Park Subdivision, Section Three and 1 2 the City of Houston limits to the southwest corner of Melrose Park Subdivision, Section Three; 3 4 THENCE, in an easterly direction, 233 feet, more or less, 5 along the south line of Melrose Park Subdivision, Section Three and 6 the City of Houston limits to the northwest corner of Melrose Park 7 Subdivision, Section Four; THENCE, in a southerly direction, 0.1 mile, more or less, 8 9 along the west line of Melrose Park Subdivision, Section Four and the City of Houston limits to the most southerly corner of Lot 10 twenty-two, Block Three of Melrose Park Subdivision, Section Four; 11 12 THENCE, in an easterly direction, 0.04 mile, more or less, along the south line of Lots Twenty-one, Twenty and Nineteen, Block 13 Three of Melrose Park Subdivision, Section Four, and the City of 14 15 Houston limits to the northwesterly corner of Lot Eleven, Block 16 Three of Melrose Park Subdivision, Section Four; 17 THENCE, in a southerly direction, 0.1 mile, more or less, along the west line of Melrose Park Subdivision, Section Four and 18 the City of Houston limits passing the northerly right-of-way line 19 of Carby Road, and continuing to the intersection with the 20 21 southerly right-of-way line of Carby Road; 22 THENCE, in a westerly direction, 0.8 mile, more or less, along the southerly right-of-way line of Carby Road and the City of 23 24 Houston limits to the intersection with the easterly right-of-way 25 line of Airline Drive; 26 THENCE, in a southeasterly direction, 0.2 mile, more or less,

7	[Thence north along the east right-of-way line of Sweetwater
8	a distance of approximately 2.7 miles to the south right-of-way
9	line of West Road
10	[ <del>Thence along the south right-of-way line of West Road</del>
11	approximately 0.2 miles to the east right-of-way line of Airline
12	<del>Drive</del>
13	[ <del>Thence south along the east right-of-way line of Airline</del>
14	Drive a distance of approximately 0.9 miles to Aldine Mail Route
15	[Thence east a distance of approximately 1.5 miles to the
16	east right-of-way line of Hardy Road
17	[ <del>Thence south along the east right-of-way line of Hardy Road</del>
18	a distance of approximately 1.1 miles to the City of Houston City
19	limits
20	[ <del>Thence southwest along the north side of the City of Houston</del>
21	City limits a distance of approximately 0.5 miles
22	[Thence south a distance of approximately 0.3 miles along the
23	west side of the city limits
24	[Thence east a distance of approximately 233 feet along the
25	south side of the city limits
26	[Thence south a distance of approximately 0.2 miles to the
27	north right-of-way line of Carby Road

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1	[Thence west along the north right-of-way line of Carby Road
2	a distance of approximately 0.8 miles to the west right-of-way line
3	<del>of Airline Drive</del>
4	[Thence south on Airline Drive a distance of approximately
5	<del>0.2 miles to Canino Road</del>
6	[Thence west along the north right-of-way line of Canino Road
7	a distance of approximately 1.3 miles to the north right-of-way
8	line of Canino Road and the Point of Beginning.
9	[ <del>SAVE AND EXCEPT all tracts or parcels of land,</del>
10	rights-of-way, facilities, and improvements owned by an electric
11	utility as defined by Section 31.002, Utilities Code].
12	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
13	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
14	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
15	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
16	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
