## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the insanity defense in a criminal case. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 8.01(a), Penal Code, is amended to read 4 as follows: 5 (a) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution that, at the 6 time of the conduct charged, the actor, as a result of severe mental 7 disease or defect, did not appreciate [know] that his conduct was 8 9 wrong. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 10 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 11 12 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and 13 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes 14 of this section, an offense was committed before the effective date 15 of this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that 16 date. 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 18
