## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to requiring a voter to present proof of identification

3 and to the information required on an application for an early

- 4 ballot to be voted by mail.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 63.001, Election Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsections (b), (c), (d), and (f) and adding Subsection
- 8 (g) to read as follows:
- 9 (b) On offering to vote, a voter must present to an election
- 10 <u>officer at the polling place</u> the voter's voter registration
- 11 certificate and a Texas driver's license or personal identification
- 12 <u>card issued to the person by the Department of Public Safety</u> [to an
- 13 election officer at the polling place].
- 14 (c) On presentation of the documentation required by
- 15 Subsection (b) [a registration certificate], an election officer
- 16 shall determine whether the voter's name on the registration
- 17 certificate is on the list of registered voters for the precinct.
- 18 (d) If the voter's name is on the precinct list of
- 19 registered voters and the voter's identity can be verified from the
- 20 proof presented, the voter shall be accepted for voting.
- 21 (f) After determining whether to accept a voter, an election
- 22 officer shall return the voter's <u>documentation</u> [registration
- 23 certificate to the voter.
- 24 (g) If the requirements for identification prescribed by

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- 1 Subsection (b) are not met, the voter may be accepted for
- 2 provisional voting only under Section 63.011.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 63.006(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 (a) A voter who, when offering to vote, presents a voter
- 6 registration certificate indicating that the voter is currently
- 7 registered in the precinct in which the voter is offering to vote,
- 8 but whose name is not on the precinct list of registered voters,
- 9 shall be accepted for voting if the voter's identity can be verified
- 10 from the proof presented.
- SECTION 3. Section 63.007(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 (a) A voter who, when offering to vote, presents a voter
- 14 registration certificate indicating that the voter is currently
- 15 registered in a different precinct from the one in which the voter
- 16 is offering to vote, and whose name is not on the precinct list of
- 17 registered voters, shall be accepted for voting if the voter's
- 18 identity can be verified from the proof presented and the voter
- 19 executes an affidavit stating that the voter:
- 20 (1) is a resident of the precinct in which the voter is
- 21 offering to vote or is otherwise entitled by law to vote in that
- 22 precinct;
- 23 (2) was a resident of the precinct in which the voter
- 24 is offering to vote at the time that information on the voter's
- 25 residence address was last provided to the voter registrar;
- 26 (3) did not deliberately provide false information to
- 27 secure registration in a precinct in which the voter does not

- 1 reside; and
- 2 (4) is voting only once in the election.
- 3 SECTION 4. Section 63.008(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 (a) A voter who does not present a voter registration
- 6 certificate when offering to vote, but whose name is on the list of
- 7 registered voters for the precinct in which the voter is offering to
- 8 vote, shall be accepted for voting if the voter executes an
- 9 affidavit stating that the voter does not have the voter's voter
- 10 registration certificate in the voter's possession at the polling
- 11 place at the time of offering to vote and the voter's identity can
- 12 <u>be verified from the proof presented</u> [<del>voter presents proof of</del>
- 13 identification in a form described by Section 63.0101].
- 14 SECTION 5. Section 63.011(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (a) A person to whom Section <u>63.001(g)</u>, 63.008(b), or
- 17 63.009(a) applies may cast a provisional ballot if the person
- 18 executes an affidavit stating that the person:
- 19 (1) is a registered voter in the precinct in which the
- 20 person seeks to vote; and
- 21 (2) is eligible to vote in the election.
- SECTION 6. Section 84.002(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 23 read as follows:
- 24 (a) An early voting ballot application must include:
- 25 (1) the applicant's name, telephone number, and the
- 26 address at which the applicant is registered to vote;
- 27 (2) for an application for a ballot to be voted by mail

- on the ground of absence from the county of residence, the address
- 2 outside the applicant's county of residence to which the ballot is
- 3 to be mailed;
- 4 (3) for an application for a ballot to be voted by mail
- 5 on the ground of age or disability, the address of the hospital,
- 6 nursing home or other long-term care facility, or retirement
- 7 center, or of a person related to the applicant within the second
- 8 degree by affinity or the third degree by consanguinity, as
- 9 determined under Chapter 573, Government Code, if the applicant is
- 10 living at that address and that address is different from the
- 11 address at which the applicant is registered to vote;
- 12 (4) for an application for a ballot to be voted by mail
- on the ground of confinement in jail, the address of the jail or of a
- 14 person related to the applicant within the degree described by
- 15 Subdivision (3);
- 16 (5) for an application for a ballot to be voted by mail
- 17 on any ground, an indication of each election for which the
- 18 applicant is applying for a ballot; [and]
- 19 (6) an indication of the ground of eligibility for
- 20 early voting; and
- 21 (7) the applicant's Texas driver's license number or
- 22 the number of a personal identification card issued to the
- 23 applicant by the Department of Public Safety.
- SECTION 7. Section 84.011(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 25 read as follows:
- 26 (a) The officially prescribed application form for an early
- 27 voting ballot must include:

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- 1 (1) immediately preceding the signature space the
- 2 statement: "I certify that the information given in this
- 3 application is true, and I understand that giving false information
- 4 in this application is a crime.";
- 5 (2) a statement informing the applicant of the
- offenses prescribed by Sections 84.003 and 84.004;
- 7 (3) spaces for entering an applicant's voter
- 8 registration number and county election precinct of registration,
- 9 with a statement informing the applicant that failure to furnish
- 10 that information does not invalidate the application; and
- 11 (4) on an application for a ballot to be voted by mail:
- 12 (A) a space for an applicant applying on the
- 13 ground of absence from the county of residence to indicate the date
- 14 on or after which the applicant can receive mail at the address
- 15 outside the county;
- 16 (B) a space for indicating the fact that an
- 17 applicant whose application is signed by a witness cannot make the
- 18 applicant's mark and a space for indicating the relationship or
- 19 lack of relationship of the witness to the applicant;
- 20 (C) a space for entering an applicant's telephone
- 21 number [, with a statement informing the applicant that failure to
- 22 <u>furnish that information does not invalidate the application</u>];
- (D) a space or box for an applicant applying on
- 24 the ground of age or disability to indicate that the address to
- 25 which the ballot is to be mailed is the address of a facility or
- relative described by Section 84.002(a)(3), if applicable;
- 27 (E) a space or box for an applicant applying on

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- 1 the ground of confinement in jail to indicate that the address to
- 2 which the ballot is to be mailed is the address of a relative
- 3 described by Section 84.002(a)(4), if applicable;
- 4 (F) spaces for entering the signature, printed
- 5 name, and residence address of any person assisting the applicant;
- 6 (G) a statement informing the applicant of the
- 7 condition prescribed by Section 81.005; [and]
- 8 (H) a statement informing the applicant of the
- 9 requirement prescribed by Section 86.003(c); and
- 10 <u>(I) a space for the applicant's Texas driver's</u>
- 11 license number or the number of a personal identification card
- issued to the applicant by the Department of Public Safety.
- SECTION 8. Section 63.0101, Election Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
