5 SECTION 1. Section 826.0211(b), Health and Safety Code, is

- 15 the information under Chapter 552, Government Code, and may not use

- SECTION 2. Section 826.0311(b), Health and Safety Code, is
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- 20 (b) The information may be disclosed only to a governmental

- 23 services for the governmental entity for purposes related to the

- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
